Archdiocese Requirements for Volunteers Who Have Contact with Children

The Archdiocese of Louisville requires any employee or volunteer who has contact with children for any length of time to complete a two-step process:

- Archdiocesan approved background check (should be done first)
- 2. Attend an IN PERSON Safe Environment Training (SET) provided through the Archdiocese.

PTO volunteers with any contact with children are required to be sent to the Parish office for verification of compliance with this policy before we are allowed to add you to and official volunteer list.
