
Welcome Home!

12 6th-8th grade students participated in the annual District Governor's Cup this past weekend. This was a culmination of months of team practices and Quick Recall matches at various schools throughout the season. Congrats to all our students and our coaches, Mrs. Shelby James and Mrs. Brittany Howell.

8th grader Beckham Bauer placed 3rd in Math and will advance to Regionals on Saturday, February 10th at South Oldham. He could then potentially move onto State Finals at the Galt House March 8-11th.

St. Patrick was recognized with the Sportsmanship Award. This award is voted on by peer representatives from all schools.

More information on the annual Kentucky's Governor's Cup Competition:

- Governor's Cup encourages depth and breadth of academic knowledge, cultural literacy, teamwork, leadership, creativity, risk assessment, and critical thinking, and provides the fun that comes with being part of a team. Established in 1985, KAAC now serves over 20,000 students and nearly 1200 schools at over 400 competitions each year.
- The competition takes place across the state of Kentucky. There are 4 districts in Louisville and surrounding counties. District winners advance to compete against the other 3 districts in Regionals.
- Areas of expertise in the competition are: written composition, assessments (math, science, social studies, language arts, and arts and humanities), Quick Recall, and Future Problem Solvers.
- Two students compete in each assessment and composition, and a minimum of four can play in quick recall. Each student can compete in up to 3 categories.


